Auditions for the festival and the plays involved, will be held at WTC on Sunday 27 January 2019, at 2pm, as well as Monday 28 January 2019 at 7pm. (Those interested can attend either of the two). There will also be call-back auditions, where required. Anyone interested in auditioning, but can't make these audition days, please contact us if you have are unable to attend, but serious about auditioning. Actors are also welcome to audition and act in more than one play!

The plays that are involved in this year's festival, promise to be a kaleidoscope of quality theatre, as the scripts are all award-winning scripts, as well as award-winning plays! Just to give you a taste.... we have mystery farces (ooooo), some riveting drama (OOOH!), some light drama/comedy (aaaah!) and some eye-watering comedies (Yeaaaah!).
